What is the Resident Services Program?

Resident Services are available to all residents that reside at one of our seven elderly & disabled housing sites (locations listed on reverse side). Services are designed to assist residents in living independently.



Services include: transportation, personal care assistance, house cleaning, grocery shopping, errands, laundry, meals and advocacy & referral for other needed services.

HOMEMAKER PROGRAM:

House cleaning, grocery shopping, errands, and laundry.

\$17.00/hr.

MEAL PROGRAM:

A hot well-balanced meal is served Monday thru Friday at Malvern Belmont, Ridge Apts., and Maple Lane Apts. Home delivered meals can also be made for those that are unable to get to a meal site. \$3.00 per meal, suggested donation

TRANSPORTATION:

Our on-site van service is available for shopping and appointments. Please call at least 48 hours in advance to schedule a driver pick up. \$5.00—\$15.00 per round-trip ride

PERSONAL CARE ASSISTANCE:

Assistance with meal preparation, personal hygiene/bathing, and medication cueing.

\$17.00/hr.

ADVOCACY & REFERRAL

SERVICE:

A Service Coordinator visits each housing site. The Coordinator is able to assess your in-home needs and make referrals as needed. If you need help with paperwork, etc. we can help!

Is there any help in paying for my Resident Services?

Yes, we are a State subsidized Independent Housing Services Program. Which means we are able to offer a “package” of services for a resident for a low monthly payment. If you would like to ask for an assessment to be conducted in order to determine if you are eligible please call Roberta: 288-4770

Here are few eligibility

requirements:

- Assets must be less than \$50,000 for 1 or \$75,000 for 2
- Must need assistance with at least 3 IADL's: main meal prep, routine cleaning, grocery shopping, laundry OR limited assistance and one person physical support in personal hygiene and/or dressing AND 2 IADL's from above.

Services covered are: homemaking, errands, grocery shopping, laundry, incidental personal care, and transportation.
